**ASSENTED TO MOTION TO DELAY APPROVAL OF COMMUTATION
AGREEMENT WITH COPENHAGEN REINSURANCE COMPANY, LIMITED**

NOW COMES General Cable Company, Inc. ("General Cable"), by their attorneys, Gallagher, Callahan & Gartrell, P.A., and requests this Honorable Court to delay its ruling on the Liquidator's Motion For Approval Of Reinsurance Commutation Agreement With The Copenhagen Reinsurance Company Limited ("Copenhagen") until September 8, 2003 or anytime thereafter.

In support thereof, the State makes the following statements:

1. On August 22, 2003, the liquidator filed its motion for approval of a reinsurance commutation agreement with Copenhagen.
2. Under the procedural order governing commutation agreements, General Cable, as an interested party, has exercised its right to request review of certain confidential terms of the commutation agreement.
3. Logistically, this review cannot be carried out within the ten day period for filing an opposition to the proposed commutation agreement. Therefore, General Cable requests that the State take no action with respect to the proposed commutation agreement until September 8, 2003 at the earliest.

4. On information and belief, the minimal delay requested will not prejudice the State or creditors in any way.

5. If, and to the extent that General Cable's review of the materials provide grounds for objection, General Cable would seek leave of the Court to file its objection beyond the ten day period provided for by the procedural order and would file the same prior to the end of business on Monday, September 8, 2003.

WHEREFORE, General Cable respectfully requests that the Court issue an order:

A. Delaying any action on the Liquidator's Assented To Motion For Approval Of Reinsurance Commutation Agreement With The Copenhagen Reinsurance Company Limited until September 8, 2003 at the earliest; and

B. Granting such other and further relief as justice requires.




