**LIQUIDATOR'S ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO ENLARGE TIME TO
RESPOND TO CENTURY INDEMNITY COMPANY'S MOTION FOR
STAY OF ARBITRATION**

Pursuant to Superior Court Rule 12, Roger A. Sevigny, Commissioner of Insurance for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of the Home Insurance Company ("Home"), hereby moves that the Court enter an order enlarging the time in which the Liquidator may file his objection to the Motion for Stay of Arbitration of KWELM Claims Against Home filed by Century Indemnity Company ("CIC") to and including January 5, 2007. As reasons therefor, the Liquidator states:

1. CIC filed its Motion for Stay of Arbitration of KWELM Claims Against Home on December 15, 2006, and the Liquidator's objection is due on December 26, 2006.
2. In light of holiday schedules, the Liquidator needs the additional time requested to prepare the objection to CIC's motion.
3. Counsel for the Liquidator has conferred with counsel for CIC, and CIC assents to the Liquidator's motion to enlarge the time to respond to CIC's motion to and including January 5, 2007.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator requests that this motion to enlarge time be granted.



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
