**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
WITH MALLINCKRODT**

On consideration of the motion of Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company (“Home”), for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (“Settlement Agreement”) between Mallinckrodt Inc., a Delaware corporation now known as Mallinckrodt LLC (“Mallinckrodt”) and Mallinckrodt US LLC, formerly known as Mallinckrodt Inc., a New York corporation, for itself and as successor in interest to Commercial Solvents Corporation and International Mineral & Chemical Corporation (“Mallinckrodt/IMC”) (Mallinckrodt and Mallinckrodt/IMC are, collectively, “Claimant”) and the Liquidator, and the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;

2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Mallinckrodt is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and

3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the Claimant’s proofs of claim as set forth in the Motion is approved, and Claimant’s claims as set forth in the Motion are allowed as Class II claims in the aggregate amount of \$10,569,391.
