**ORDER APPROVING
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH EVERSOURCE**

On consideration of (a) the motion of Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company (“Home”), for an order approving A Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (“Settlement Agreement”) between Eversource Energy, formerly known as Northeast Utilities, as successor in interest to Northeast Utilities, The Connecticut Light and Power Company, and Public Service Company of New Hampshire (“Eversource”), and the Liquidator, and (b) the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;

2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Eversource is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and

3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the Eversource claim is approved, and the \$3,000,000 settlement amount is allowed as an unexcused late-filed Class II claim of Eversource.
