**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
WITH NEENAH-MENASHA SEWERAGE COMMISSION**

On consideration of (a) the motion of Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company, for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (“Settlement Agreement”) between Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission and the Liquidator, and (b) the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and
3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the proofs of claim filed by Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission is approved and Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission’s claim is allowed as an unexcused late-filed Class II claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45, RSA 402-C:44, and RSA 402-C:37 in the aggregate amount of \$525,000.
