ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT  
WITH VIACOMCBS INC.

On consideration of (a) the motion of Christopher R. Nicolopoulos, Insurance Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company, for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (“Settlement Agreement”) between ViacomCBS Inc., successor to Westinghouse Electric Corporation (“Claimant”) and the Liquidator, and (b) the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with ViacomCBS Inc. is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and
3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the proofs of claim filed by Claimant is approved and Claimant’s claim is allowed as a Class II claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45 and RSA 402-C:44 in the amount of \$5,244,128. This allowance is in addition to the Westinghouse Prior Allowances approved November 13, 2006 and October 31, 2008, the Workers Compensation Allowance approved November 16, 2015, and the CBS Operations Allowance approved May 5, 2016.
