## ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

On consideration of (a) the motion of Christopher R. Nicolopoulos, Insurance
Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home
Insurance Company, for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release
("Settlement Agreement") between American Electric Power Company, Inc., Ohio Power
Company (successor by merger to Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company), AEP Texas
Inc. (successor to Central and South West Corporation, Central Power and Light Company and
West Texas Utilities), Public Service Company of Oklahoma, and Southwestern Electric Power
Company (collectively "Claimants"), and the Liquidator, and (b) the supporting Affidavit of
Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
- 2. The Liquidator's Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with American Electric Power Company is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and
- 3. The Liquidator's recommendation concerning the allowance of the proofs of claim filed by Claimants is approved and Claimants' claims are allowed as a Class II claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45 and RSA 402-C:44 in the amount of \$6,554,841.
