**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT WITH INDIANAPOLIS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY**

On consideration of (a) the motion of David J. Bettencourt, Insurance Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company, for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (“Settlement Agreement”) between Indianapolis Power & Light Company (d/b/a AES Indiana) (“Indianapolis Power & Light”) and the Liquidator, and (b) the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Indianapolis Power & Light Company is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and
3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the proof of claim filed by Indianapolis Power & Light is approved and Indianapolis Power & Light’s claim is allowed as a Class II claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45 and RSA 402-C:44 in the amount of \$23,289,294.
