This letter responds to the Request for Review submitted by you on behalf of CIRC pursuant to your September 20, 2005 communication and is being directed to your attention in accordance with the request contained in the Acknowledgement of Receipt executed by ACE INA's Vice-President that was attached to your communication. The purpose of this letter is to provide CIRC with a Redetermination of claims presented to The Home Insurance Company in Liquidation ("The Home"), under the Proof of Claim ("POC") specified above. The Home expects to present notice of this Redetermination to the Superior Court for Merrimack County. New Hampshire (the "Court") for approval in accordance with New Hampshire Revised Statute, RSA 402-C:45. The Home has considered CIRC's Request for Review and has made a Redetermination as set forth above in accordance with The Homo Claim Procedures (the "Procedures") approved by the Court.

Despite the reasons advanced in the Request for Review, we do not believe that any legitimate rationale has been proffered to justify the request that the Notice of Determination issued herein (the "NOD") should be modified. In that regard, notwithstanding latter day protestations by your firm as set forth in the September 12, 2003 correspondence attached to the Request for Review, we believe it axiomatic that CIRC is not a beneficiary under the subject Quota Share Reinsurance Treaty Agreement, having due regard to, inter alia, the definition of Indemnitees contained therein and the definition of the term AFIA Entity set forth in Clause 4.1 (a) of Purchase Agreement No. 1 entered into on December 30, 1983 by and between, amongst others, CIGNA Corporation and The Home Insurance Company. Indeed, the fact that

CIRC is not a beneficiary was confirmed in deposition as an "admission against interest" by Mike Durkin. As such, we reaffirm the determination contained in the NOD that the instant claim be disallowed and, as a result, renterate our rejection and denial of any and all offsets asserted by CIRC with respect to payments effected by it (which we refute were effected for and on behalf of Century Indemnity Company) against amounts purportedly owing by Home pursuant to said Quota Share Agreement.

If CIRC wishes to dispute the Redetermination or creditor classification for any reason, it may file an Objection with the Court at

A timely filed Objection will be treated as a Disputed Claim and will be referred to the Liquidation Clerk's Office for adjudication in accordance with the Procedures. Please also sign and return the Acknowledgment of Receipt form and mail a copy of the Objection to the Liquidator.
