This is a Motion Request to move this Court to Approve the ENTIRE Claim & Mandatory Disclosure for pain & suffering, further treatment involving " THIS LIFE LONG CLAIM "

- 1) I, William F Wills am an Authorized Representative for Gregory M Wills (my son) I don't have Legal understanding of the Legal Language involving Court Laws & Schedule Pursuants, I am not an Attorney or familiar with Legal Procedures.
- 2) My Sworn Representative Authorization Affidavit dated 27, September 2011 .under Tab-E.
- 3) Gregory M Wills Sworn Authorization Affidavit dated 23, September 2012 giving me authorization to represent him is under Tab-E
- 4) I am a trusting individual with values & senior citizen, & former U S Marine. I trust until I find out different. The Home Insurance Company & Risk Enterprise Management Ltd. were involved in this claim for the liability injury accident caused to my 8 yr old at the time of the injury . .Ref; My sworn Affidavit Request for Review by The Court Judge dated 16, January 2012 addressed to: City Of Concord , Town Of Merrimack, State of New Hampshire, Office of Clerk, Merrimack County Superior Court , It is my Request for a Review Decision from the Court, I mailed a copy to Mr. Peter Bengelsdorf, I never received Notice or a decision on it from the Court. I filed my Objection Acknowledgement of Receipt Form dated and signed by me on 16, January 2012 mailed back, addressed to Mr. Peter Bengelsdorf via U S Postal Service Return Receipt Requested Article#: 7011 0470 0001 9384 6980 with copy addressed to The Office of the Clerk Merrimack County Superior Court , mailed to both on 17, January 2012, After I received the secured binder file from Mr. Eric A Smith for Rackemann Sawyer & Brewster I got very concerned because my signature "in INK" was removed from the form. I immediately sent "Urgent" email to Mr. Eric Smith via email dated 29, Feb. 2012. & copy of the email to the Office of The Liquidator Clerk % Merrimack County Superior Court via email @help@hiciiclerk.org Because of my concern I followed up with a letter dated dated 1, March

2012 addressed to Mr, Eric A Smith for Rackemann Sawyer & Brewster with copy mailed addressed to ; Office of the Clerk % Merrimack Superior Court.

5) I received a Supplemental Case File from Mr. Eric Smith, for Rackemann Brewster & Sawyer " Before The Court Appointed Referee," Table of Contents. A. Objection under Tab-A. B.. Correspondence March 1, 2012 under Tab-B . C. Response/Amendment of Notice of Determination - March 9, 2012. with a letter from him also dated 9, March 2012 stating The Liquidator issues this Amendment Notice of Determination in spirit of compromise, The Liquidator hereby amends the Notice of Determination dated 19, December 2011 regarding POC # CLMN713953-01 his letter also state he represent Roger A Savigny, New Hampshire Insurance Commissioner as the Liquidator of the Home Insurance Co, In Liquidation , That is the FIRST time he advised me he was NOT representing me.

6) I received a SECOND Supplemental Case File from Mr. Eric A Smith for Rackemann Sawyer & Brewster "Before the Court Appointed Referee. Table of Contents A Correspondence from Claimant 19, March 2012, B. Correspondence from Liquidator 23, March 2012, C Correspondence from Claimant 5, June 2012 D. Correspondence from Liquidator 6, July 2012 he had a letter attached dated 6, July 2012 stating; The Liquidator will include the \$2,150, Class 11 amended allowance for the claim in Liquidation next report claims and recommendation to the Court Approval of the recommendation allowance by the Court .is the official action recognized the allowance & making it eligible to participate in Class 11 percentage distribution. as they are made. Once the Court approves the allowance by approving the claims report, the Liquidator will request that the referee dismiss this disputed claim proceeding 2012-HICIL-54, He state the Liquidator has received a new proof of claim for future dental expenses dated 5, June 2012, The proof of claim has been assigned CLMN714296.

7) I received a letter dated 16, October 2012 from Office of the Liquidator Clerk Ms. Ainsworth, Liquidator Clerk regarding Disputed Claim No. 2012-HIC-54 advising they have received the file from Attorney Smith but, have yet to receive the mandatory disclosure stating if I intend to dispute this claim to file my mandatory disclosure within 30 days. she cc; Mr Eric Smith via email. I was totally shocked to have read it . I emailed Mr Smith on 19, October 2012 & expressed my concerns to him , it was crystal clear to me that every thing was processed in court order pending payment distribution. Mr. Eric Smith for Rackemann Sawyer & Brewster responded to me email the same day (19. Oct. 2012) Stating; he represent The Liquidator of Home & cant give advice but, offered the following. Assuming the proceeding is dismissed on the Liquidators Motion it will not be necessary for me to make the mandatory disclosure because the proceeding will be terminated. The claim is subject to court approval,. It sounds to me that was the decision already made to dismiss & terminate it. I agreed to what he was asking of me in Good Faith that now appears not to be the case

Now that I understand what Mandatory Disclosure mean I have made my mandatory disclosure in Poc# CLMN713953 with the filings, bills letters from dentist etc. to go before the Court Judge.


I have filed the bills for the new Poc# CLMN714296. All the documents has been filed /mailed via U S Postal Service. I am making this Motion to Move This Court to Hear this case & take in to consideration ALL of my mandatory disclosures I have filed/mailed. I am requesting a decision from the Judge at this point because now it appears all I was agreeing with thru Mr.Eric Smith for Rackemann Sawyer & Brewster were NOT in my best interest in representation of Gregory Wills who has endured pain & suffering from the damage to his two front teeth and for further pain & dental work for his two front teeth if need be. The mandatory disclosure I made in POC# 713953-01 is for \$200.000.00.
