**LIQUIDATOR'S AND CLAIMANTS'
JOINT MOTION TO STAY DISPUTED CLAIM PROCEEDING**

Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company (“Home”), and Western Asbestos Settlement Trust, in its capacity as the sole owner of Western Asbestos Company, and pursuant to the authority granted in the Order Confirming Second Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization and Granting Related Relief as the successor to MacArthur Co. and Western MacArthur Co. to “initiate, prosecute, defend and resolve” all Asbestos Insurance Actions in the name of MacArthur Co., Western MacArthur Co. and/or Western Asbestos Company (collectively, “Claimants”), hereby jointly move that the Referee issue an order staying this disputed claim proceeding. As reasons therefor, the Liquidator and Claimants state:

1. The Claimants and the Liquidator have reached a settlement of Claimants' claims. The settlement is set forth in a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release dated February 18, 2011 ("Settlement Agreement"). The Settlement Agreement is subject to approval of the Court in the Home liquidation proceeding.

2. On March 8, 2011, the Liquidator filed the Liquidator's Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Western Asbestos Settlement Trust in the Home liquidation proceeding.

3. Under the Settlement Agreement, this disputed claim proceeding will be dismissed following approval of the Settlement Agreement by the Court.

4. In the circumstances, this disputed claim proceeding should be stayed pending action by the Court on the Liquidator's motion for approval of the Settlement Agreement.

WHEREFORE, the Claimants and the Liquidator jointly request that the Referee:

(a) Grant this motion;

(b) Issue an order staying this disputed claim proceeding until the Court has ruled upon the Liquidator's motion for approval of the Settlement Agreement; and

(c) Grant such other relief as justice may require.




